GUIDELINES FOR YARD CARDS FROM EPIC PRINT CONCEPTS

1) You will need two stakes for each sign in creating your design. Otherwise, the wind will blow them around and they could end up facing backwards. You can use “H” stakes from Lowe’s, Home Depot, or even Amazon too. We do not presently carry them. Most of the time, there are two sizes: 15” X 30” and 10” X 15”.

2) Use the taller stakes for your back row, to create height. Shorter stakes are for the front row. From time to time during setting up your event, step back a bit to see what your display looks like. Some yards will allow you to easily push signs into ground. Always use the stakes attached to the sign to push the sign down into the ground and never press on the letter (or sign). If the ground is hard, you can push the stakes in first, and then put the sign onto the stakes, or you can carry a small hammer to help hammer the stakes into the ground. A screwdriver or other pointy tool to make holes in the yard may come in handy also.

3) All signs are weather resistant for rain/snow but keep a towel on hand. When you pick up your signs from an event, see if they are damp or wet. If so, please dry them off before stacking them one against the other. If damp/wet signs are stacked, so they touch, it may adversely affect the look of the sign itself.

4) If you are using stars, the correct place to attach the stake against the star is found by looking along the edge and finding the one that shows UNIFORM squares all the way from left to right. If there are any angled squares, that is NOT where you want to place the stake.

5) When dismantling a yard card display, please remember to look over the yard to be sure no stakes are left behind. You will need them for your next display. This will also eliminate any dangers to others or lawn mowers....etc. you get the idea!
